

Annual Meeting of the Electors of Brancaster Parish

Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 7th March 2023 at 6.30pm

The meeting was held in Brancaster Staithe Village Hall.

The meeting was chaired by Cllr Richard Roberts, Vice-Chairman of the Parish Council, in the absence of the Chairman.

Also in attendance around 20 members of the public, including Councillors, and Simon Bower, Parish Clerk, taking notes.

Meeting began at 6.30pm

1. Cllr Roberts welcomed everyone to the meeting.
2. There were apologies for absence from (Cllrs) Tom de Winton, Bob Lawton and Christopher Pratt.
3. The minutes of the meeting on 5th April 2022 were accepted as a true record and duly signed.
4. Cllr Roberts echoed the comment from Cllr Bax last year that it had been "interesting", especially with the situation regarding possible car parks.
5. He invited members of groups present to comment. Val Carpenter (Brancaster Parking and Safety Team) commented that things were going along well, and that the formal consultation (on yellow lines etc.) was expected soon. Briony Bax said that the Coronation planning was going well – it was planned to produce a brochure and she hoped that it would be a "lovely weekend". Anthony Law (Brancaster Sports Club) noted that the Petanque Court had been added during the year, with help from the PC, and that their AGM would be on 23rd March.
